# Student Agreement

Any missed classes will be redeemed as required within a two week period up to 16 total periods missed. I understand that if I miss more than 16 periods of a subject in a semester then I will be withdrawn from that subject (this includes absences with a medical certificate or similar).	
Behaviour	I understand that Swinburne is a safe space for all staff and students. I accept that Swinburne does not condone anti-social behaviour (including physical, social or emotional) of any kind either in-person or online.	
	I accept that Swinburne does not tolerate the use of any e-cigarettes, vaping, or smoking inside the school grounds or within viewing distance of the school.	
	I accept that Swinburne does not tolerate any students using or being under the influence of any drugs, alcohol or illicit substances. I accept that I will be held accountable for being in the presence of another student using drugs, alcohol or illicit substances. I understand that this applies both on school grounds and within the proximity of the school grounds.	
	I agree not to intentionally damage or graffiti any school property.	
Subject requirements	I agree to complete all assessments (SACs/SATs/EATs) and the 50 hours of coursework set for each Unit to the best of my ability and by the due date set by the subject teacher. I will provide a medical certificate for any missed assessment and organise with the relevant subject teacher to complete the assessment within two weeks of the original due date to be eligible for a score.	
College activities	I agree to participate positively in Swinburne events and activities. I will utilise my time on Wednesdays to self-manage my own learning and attend any school organised events and activities.
